

Visitor's COVID-19 Safety Agreement

We warmly welcome our visitors. With the COVID-19 Pandemic we have had to add to our current terms and conditions in line with government outlines to protect our staff, contractor and visitors.

What Parenting 2000 has put in place to protect staff and our visitors

1. Our premises will be cleaned/sanitised regularly.
2. Communal areas and surfaces are cleaning repeatedly throughout the day.
3. We have installed no touch hand soaps in bathrooms and use disposable hand towels.
4. Our reception staff are behind a screen.
5. All staff have access to PPE and hand sanitiser.
6. Appropriate social distancing rules dictated by UK Government specifications are in place for staff and services users.
7. All staff and contractors declare on entering the building that they are fit and well to work (COVID symptom free).
8. All staff and contractors declare on entering the building that they have not been in proximity of anyone who may have COVID-19.

What we need our visitors to do to keep themselves and our staff safe

1. All service users will be asked to declare on entering the building that they are fit and well to work (COVID symptom free) that they have not been in proximity of anyone who may have COVID-19.
2. Visitors will be required to abide by face covering legislation for community centres which means that visitors are obliged to wear face coverings in communal areas such as corridors and waiting rooms.
3. Room hirers may be asked to forward Parenting a 2000 a risk assessment at least one week before their booking.
4. Visitors will be requested to observe our current social distancing rules dictated by UK Government specifications that are in place for staff and services users. Our notice board on reception will detail this.
5. Parenting 2000 will limit numbers of people who are allowed in the building at any one time. This will be published on the door. People may be required to wait outside.
6. Room hirers will be required to provide hand sanitisers for themselves and their own service users.
7. All visitors are requested to wash hands at regular intervals.
8. Toilets will be cleaned/sterilised before usage as part of Parenting 2000 regular cleaning and there will be wipes/cleaning spray for door handles and toilets for visitors to use to clean before and after their visit.
9. Rooms will be cleaned/sterilised before usage as part of Parenting 2000 regular cleaning. There will be wipes/cleaning spray for door handles and surfaces for visitors hiring rooms to use.
10. Parenting 2000 will not permit the storage of items on our premises. All room hirers must not leave any belongings on the premises between usage and/or overnight.
